How Much Does This Cost?

- \$150.00 for a 50 gallon water heater purchased from Fulton County REMC, once qualified.
 - 6 year tank warranty
 - 1 year parts warranty
 - Meets or exceeds 1190 efficiency standards
 - Foam insulation
 - Factory installed temperature and pressure relief valve
- \$100.00 rebate if member buys their own 40 gallon or larger water heater somewhere else.

To Qualify:

- Be a member of Fulton County REMC.
- Water heater must be installed in a full time residence on REMC lines.
- Must consent to have our load management switch installed on your new electric water heater.
- Pick up your water heater and have it installed within 30 days.
- Must call the REMC to have water heater inspected and load management switch installed.
- Say "yes" to free maintenance on the water heater as long as the switch remains in place.
- A Mobile Home or Doublewide must be mounted on a permanent foundation.

Making Wise Energy Choices
